- general pedagogy
- designed to meet the needs of ELL (English Language Learners) must be close to 100% ELL

"Acceptable CTLE must be conducted through activities designed to improve the teacher or leader's pedagogical and/or leadership skills, targeted at improving student performance, including but not limited to formal CTLE activities. Such activities shall promote the professionalization of teaching and educational leadership, as applicable, and be closely aligned to district goals for student performance" (http://www.highered.nysed.gov/tcert/resteachers/ctle.html#acceptable).

CTLE presenters must hold certification and/or have specialized approved training in the topic they are presenting. Resumes must be provided.
